Fort Worth, Texas- Three U.S. Air Force F-35 Lightning II Joint Strike Fighter jets (tail numbers AF-14, AF-15 and AF-16) are the latest to be delivered from Lockheed Martin to the U.S. Government. The jets will be used to support pilot training at the 33rd Fighter Wing at Eglin Air Force Base. The 33rd Fighter Wing recently completed 100 F-35 flights. The F-35 Integrated Training Center at Eglin is preparing for full rate F-35 pilot training for Air Force, Navy, Marine Corps and international F-35 partner nation pilots in the coming year.
