The Joint Strike Fighter Program Office, Arlington, Virginia, is in the process of conducting a source selection for the Joint Strike Fighter (JSF) Engineering and Manufacturing Development (EMD) Phase between The Boeing Company and Lockheed Martin Aeronautics Company. The purpose of this program is to develop a family of JSF air systems to meet the needs of the U.S. Air Force, U.S. Navy, U.S. Marine Corps and United Kingdom Navy and Air Force.

An important consideration in proposal evaluation is the verification of the Offerors' past and present performance on contracts that reflect the Offerors' ability to perform on the proposed effort. This program depends on information received from agencies such as yours, that have first hand experience in the evaluation of the Offerors' past and present performance on those contracts.



As there is potentially significant reliance on the Performance Risk Assessment Group (PRAG) information, I urge you to dedicate the appropriate amount of time and effort to make this a useful endeavor.

NOTE: DO NOT RETURN QUESTIONNAIRES TO OFFEROR/CONTRACTOR! Once the questionnaire is filled out, it becomes source selection sensitive and needs to be handled accordingly.
