Mr. Justin T. Meyer, SES

Mr. Justin T. Meyer, a member of the Senior Executive Service, is the Executive Director for the F-35 Lightning II Joint Program Office in Arlington, VA. Mr. Meyer is responsible for acquiring and delivering the Department of War capable, affordable and sustainable fifth-generation strike aircraft, as well as the F-35 Global Sustainment Strategy, for three U.S. Services, seven Partner nations and 12 Foreign Military Sales nations.

From November 2022 to January 2026, Mr. Meyer served as the Executive Director for Program Executive Office Aircraft Carriers. In this role, he was the senior civilian official providing leadership over a \$50 billion portfolio. His responsibilities included the design and construction of Gerald R. Ford-class carriers, the mid-life refueling overhauls for Nimitz-class carriers and life cycle support for all active aircraft carriers. He also regularly engages with congressional committees as well as international and industry partners.

Mr. Meyer is a native of Danville, California, and holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering from The California Maritime Academy and a Master of Science degree in Engineering Management from The Catholic University of America. He is a member of the Acquisition Professional Community with a Level III Certification in Program Management and holds Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act certifications in Systems Engineering and International Program Management.

Mr. Meyer's military and civilian decorations include the Navy Meritorious Civilian Service Award, Meritorious Unit Commendation, Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal, Navy Meritorious Achievement Commendation, National Defense Service Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service and Expeditionary Medals and a Flag Level of Commendation.
